

CSU Channel Islands Psi Chi Membership Application

Three Steps to Membership

1. Fill out the online Psi Chi Application.
2. Once you are accepted, you will be asked to submit a one-time life-time membership fee of \$100 with a check made out to CSUCI Psi Chi. This fee includes, the international society member fees (\$55), regalia (\$20) and CI club fees (\$25).
3. Attend the Fall 2021 induction ceremony receive your certificate and membership card.

Invitation to Membership

The CI Chapter of Psi Chi cordially invites you to apply for membership. Psi Chi is the International Honor Society in Psychology, and membership depends upon class standing and academic achievement. Membership has a lifetime benefits.

Once you submit your online application, Psi Chi will review it and determine your eligibility. If you qualify, you will receive an email confirmation regarding the acceptance decision.

1. Apply for Psi Chi Membership at <http://www.psichi.org/?page=JoinToday>.
2. Read the qualifications for application and select APPLY NOW.
3. Choose [school name] from the Local Chapter drop-down menu and fill out the application including your name, email address, and Student ID No.
4. It will also ask you for your exact graduation date. Use the commencement date listed on the CSUCI Academic Calendar.
5. At the bottom of the page, check the box authorizing the faculty advisor to review your college records to determine eligibility.
6. Type your Name/Signature and select SUBMIT.

Minimum Qualifications

Minimum 3 completed Psychology courses with a cumulative CSUCI of the top 35% of your cohort and Psychology GPA of 3.50. Transfer students need to complete at least 12 units at CSUCI, including at least one Psychology course, in addition to the above requirements before they are eligible to apply.
